### Literacy

In Literacy this week children will be writing their information texts. They have spent the last two weeks planning and researching countries in Africa. This week they will turn their notes into sentences and write their first drafts. They will then edit and improve their work to create their final piece of work.

### Maths

In Maths this week the children will be recapping strategies for addition and subtraction. We will start by adding and subtracting a multiple of 10 to and from a 2- or 3-digit number and moving on to working with other two and three digit numbers if appropriate.

### Themed Learning

In Science this week we will start a new unit on magnets and springs. The children will be encouraged to think about what they know already about magnets before carrying out some explorations to find out what happens when the different poles are put together.

This week in Humanities, the children will be looking at timelines. They will learn how to construct a timeline to order important events in their own lives. Then they will see how this relates to Egypt and will order important events in Egyptian history.

In Art this week children will complete their African weaving and add beads and feathers to embellish their work. We will then start our work on printing and create monoprints of African patterns.

### PSHCE

In PSHCE we are looking at the charity Water Aid. We will be finding out about the work they do in Africa.

### Computing

Children will continue with their cartoon this week, using all the skills they have learnt over previous weeks to improve it.

### Vocabulary

**Literacy**- information, research, notes, write, draft, edit, improve.

**Numeracy**- add, subtract, minus, increase, decrease, more than, less than.

### Themed Learning

**Science** – magnets, pole, attract, repel, north, south.
