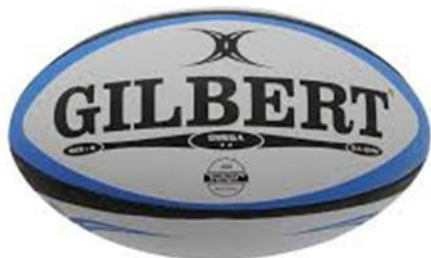


U11 (Year 6) Contact Rugby vs Repton @ Repton School
