



At-a-glance Tanzania guide

√

	Ensure all China visas for return to China are up-to-date and your passport is valid for 6 months after your return. If you have any concerns over your passports or visas- let us know!
	Check packing lists carefully and ask if you are unsure. Important items are sun-cream, wide brimmed hat, goggles, gardening gloves, 2 x 1 litre water bottles for drinking, closed toe shoes for project work, bug spray. We will have two kit checks in school to make sure everyone has what they need. *Plastic Bags are now illegal in Tanzania- there are heavy fines for bringing them into the country so DO NOT BRING THEM
	For security reasons, all electronics will be kept in a safety deposit box during the day and at night; you will have access to them for a short time in the evening to contact home. If you would like a camera, alarm clock etc. you will need to bring one separately.
	REMEMBER please ensure you have taken advice on Malaria from your own GP. As a school our only stipulation is we do not recommend Larium/Mifloquine – Any decision is at your own discretion
	If you have any medicine that you will be taking, please inform us in advance and make sure you hand it to the teachers for safe-keeping during the trip.
	You will need to confirm your attendance on the trip by 20th September in order for us to buy flights
	If you drop out of the trip after 8th October for any non-emergency reason, you may be liable for costs. These are substantial. Please see Ms Mazie as soon as possible if you have a problem.
	Most, but not all, students will require a visa. We will inform you if you do not. Otherwise, by Thursday 11th October you will need to hand to your form tutor: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Passport • completed Tanzanian Visa Application form • 2 passport photos • Parent permission form • 415RMB Visa Fee (Cash)
	If you have a Yellow Fever Vaccination already, please let us know. Otherwise the school will arrange this for the 15 th /16 th October. Please let Ms Mazie know by 11th October . You will need to pay 281RMB (Cash) and provide 1 passport photo.
	For the Yellow Fever Vaccination, you will need to have a medical examination and will be asked not to eat that morning. Please let us know if this is not possible.
	Ensure all NAE documentation completed on line with JotForm by 18th October – any difficulties please let me know. These are a waiver form and a medical info form and will be sent to parental emails.
	Pay by Event link (on school website) the Charitable donation (USD350) and insurance (USD65) before 19th November 2017 (Total: USD415/ 2966RMB). This money should be fundraised but you will need a bank card to make the payment.
	The dates for the trip are 28th November- 5th December , but we will be travelling between 27th November- 6th December .

All forms and deadlines are in the Tanzania Managebac group and available on the school website.
