#### Treasurer's report

The meeting opened with Linda Sorensen presenting the Treasurer's report. From our major events we have made a reasonable profit, such as follows:

Secret Santa Shoppe: 24700.82RMB

German Christmas Fayre: 38363RMB

We had a total outlay of 127167RMB and were able to do the first payment of the Green T. House, where we will hold our Dinner & Dance.

The steering committee and interest groups will suggest some ways to spend the money raised by last year's activities, such as equipment and appliances for the school's kitchen to be used in the PA's cooking classes or a box of useful utensils for new families that can be borrowed until they are settled in.

## School buses and bus ayis

After some issues on some of the school's buses involving attitudes towards bus ayis, Mr. Puttock will discuss further training for the bus ayis and reinforce to children that CCTV is being used at all times. The PA suggested a letter be written to parents regarding children's responsibility in the bus, reminding that children are being filmed. Language should be drafted to state the message that "school starts on the bus". Plus, Mr. Puttock will reinforce this in the primary and secondary assemblies.

## Outings during bad air days

In accordance to school policies, the PA has agreed that outings will follow the same rules: if AQI is above 250, outdoor activities will be cancelled; if the AQI is above 300, then all trips will be cancelled. Discretion may used if transport is by own vehicles and activities all take place in air-purified buildings.
