


About UNICEF and UN Global Goals

UNICEF is a United Nations organisation dedicated to defending the realisation of rights of every child globally. Through the 17 Sustainable Development Goals, the organisation aims to advance the rights and well-being of every child. As part of our philosophy to be ambitious, Nord Anglia Education has teamed up with UNICEF to help achieve two of the 17 objectives:

Goal 4 Obtaining a quality education is the foundation to improving people's lives and sustainable development.

Goal 16 Access to justice for all and building effective, accountable institutions at all levels.





As part of this challenge, UNICEF has requested Nord Anglia students to come together to design practical solutions for the needs of their community.

A group of selected students will then have the opportunity to present the impact of their projects at an event during the High-Level Political Forum on Sustainable Development. Through workshops, seminars and debates, students will learn from experts and policymakers about negotiating and the issues that plague the world today.

Accommodation, Catering and Transport

Students will travel to a hub airport in their region, and join a larger group of students to travel together to New York. From JFK airport, students will be taken a short distance to The Avalon Hotel in New York.

Students will be placed in a room with two other students of the same gender. As only two students per school will be able to attend this event, students will have a chance to meet and get to know their peers in Nord Anglia schools around the world. Each floor of the hotel will be monitored by staff from Nord Anglia Education. Students will also be given strict instructions about what to do if they need help or advice.

Catering will include a variety of packed lunches and restaurants. Please note, we will accommodate vegetarians and others with special dietary requirements.

All transport will either be on foot, by subway or by pre-arranged transfer.

Activities

A variety of additional excursions will be available; options will include a Broadway show, The Top of the Rock, One World Observation deck (all with additional cost) visits to a choice of museum or gallery, a walk around central park, and a walk through Times Square (no cost). Excursions will be fully supervised with an 8:1 student-to-staff ratio.

Fees

Nord Anglia Education is pleased to announce that the only costs for this event will be flights, visas, travel insurance, evening meals and some excursions. All other costs will be paid for by NAE when students are in New York.
