In **Numeracy**, the children will be completing their Numeracy assessments. This will cover numbers, addition, subtraction, time, shape, measure, division and multiplication.

In **Literacy**, the children will be completing a variety of different carousel activities. This will focus on sentence writing, handwriting, phonics and reading.

In **Science**, the children will be continuing to revise for their Science assessment. They will be looking at topics such as Living Things, Plants, Materials and Pushes and Pulls.

In **IPC**, the children will become world famous fashion designers and will be making their own clothes using resources found around the school.
