ENGLISH

In English, the children will complete their work on 'The Great Race'. They will re-write the story, using their knowledge of ordinal numbers to change the order in which the animals appear. The children will be encouraged to write the story independently and ensure their work includes punctuation marks, adjectives and conjunctions. Time will be given after the activity to self-assess and edit their work.



MATHEMATICS

Our Maths focus this week will be to identify ordinal numbers, to complement the story the children have been reading in English. The children will practice ordering the animals using ordinal numbers and related vocabulary.

As the Christmas season approaches, we will begin to look at capacity in a festive way. The children will use stockings, presents and ornaments to estimate and measure the capacity of different objects.



TOPIC

The Personal Goal we will be focusing on this week is being World Citizens.

The children as part of their homework task have been asked to create a Christmas card which will be given to another child in Year 1. During Guidance sessions we will discuss the meaning of sharing good will and cheer throughout the holiday season.
