- Entrance test includes English and Mathematics at BVIS.
- Interview Chosen candidates who have passed the tests shall be invited for an interview at BVIS.
- Scholarship results We shall announce the results via phone and email address listed on the Registration Form. Chosen candidates shall be advised about the process of receiving the scholarships.

Conditions

The IGCSE and A LEVEL scholarship (Year 10 – 13) are offered to students born in 2005 and currently are in Year 8 of 2018-2019 school year (equivalent to Year 9 in the English National Curriculum, 13-year system).

• Candidates shall have good ethics, excellent academic performance, GPA of 8.8 or above during the latest two school years.

IGCSE and A Level Introduction

The International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE) is a 2-year curriculum organized by Cambridge International Examination. The obligatory subjects include English, Maths, Sciences and some other optional subjects, (there are usually 8-9 optional subjects). Students who finish the IGCSE with high grades shall have an opportunity to directly take A Level.

The Advanced Level (A Level) is a 2-year curriculum organized by Cambridge International Examination. Students shall usually take 3-4 subjects. Students who finish the A Level with high grades shall have an opportunity to be directly admitted to most of top universities in the world.
