## *A Message from our Head of Early Years Phase...*



I would like to take this opportunity to tell you how excited I am about our new Early Years building.

At BSB Sanlitun, the Foundation Stage incorporates Tadpoles (1 & 2 year olds), Pre-Nursery (2 & 3 year olds), Nursery (3 & 4 year olds) and Reception (4 & 5 year olds) and we follow the British Early Years Foundation Stage framework (EYFS) which is currently being taught in all Early Years settings in the UK. The EYFS framework is based on the philosophy that young children learn best through a play-based curriculum, with a balance of adult-led and child initiated activities. Our new facilities which include: free-flow play between classrooms, two shared learning spaces, a sensory room and a soft play area as well as a cookery space and well-equipped outdoor learning provision. This will help to develop the children's learning through a variety of stimulating and challenging experiences. Our new, well stocked library will help to foster the children's love of sharing books, listening to stories and learning to read.

Our mission is to be ambitious for every student in our school, academically, socially and personally whilst fostering a love of lifelong learning in a safe, secure and happy environment.
