

The week ahead in Year 6 (31 October-2 November 2017)

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next** week.

In *Literacy*, we will be focusing on non-chronological reports. We will be looking at *The Emperor's Clothes*, before turning this story in to a report.

In *Numeracy*, we are looking at fractions. We will be familiarizing ourselves with the terms fraction, numerator, denominator and will be comparing fractions with related denominators. We will be finding the common denominators of two fractions.

In *Science*, we will be starting our new topic of 'Force and Energy'. We will be explaining the difference between mass and weight. We will then be measuring the mass and weight of different objects to investigate if there is a pattern.

Our IPC we will be evaluating what we learned during our last topic 'Building a Village' and then introducing our new topic 'Fairgrounds'. The children will be designing and building their own fairground ride in groups, which will then be combined to create a miniature fairground.

In ICT, we will be starting to look at using 'Scratch' as a program and how to create a game.

In PSHE, we will be creating a game to play as a group in the playground.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following week. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
