Starters: Reading



Create 5 questions you would ask the main character from your book if you were to meet them in real life. Try and answer the questions as if you were that character.



Create a mind map of all the emotions your main character feels throughout your story book. Explain why your character feels these emotions at the different points in the story.



Complete the Sharks comprehension that has been sent home with your child. It has also been attached.

Main Course – you **MUST** do these every week:
