

Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next week**.

In **Literacy**, we will be learning about non-chronological reports and identifying their features.

In **Numeracy**, we will be working out multiplication and division problems. We will also be using arrays to find multiples.

In **Science**, we will be doing an investigation on floating and sinking and we will be focusing on writing up the experiment.

In **IPC**, we will be thinking about what kind of ruler we would want to be, reflecting upon skills that good leaders from the past have had. We will also be learning about famous explorers, including Christopher Columbus.

In **PSHE**, we will be looking at what different families look like. We will be discussing how our families are similar and different to other families.

In **ICT**, we will be presenting our PowerPoint slides on effective communication.

For **Spellings**, please practise any words that have the following sounds in with your child. They will then be tested on 10 random words that have this sound in on Thursday to see how they are applying their phonics learning to spelling.

Mr Chad's group: 'ck' as in rock, and 'r' as in rat.

Ms Nadine's group: 'oo' as in book, and 'oo' as in food (2 different sounds!).

Mr Spencer's group: 'oi' as in coin, foil and 'ow' as in down, how.

Mrs Burgess' group: 'pr', 'cr' and 'br' as in prowl, crutch and bring.

Ms Dianne's group: revising 'ur' as in pure, 'ow' as in flower and 'oi' as in boil.

Ms Claire's group: 'oe' as in toe, and 'au' as in launch.

Ms Dipti's group: 10 Year 2 Tricky/High Frequency Words, as found in their communication book.

Ms Clara and Ms Asma's groups: 'Week 19' from the Year 2 Spelling list; the words can be found in their communication book.
