Dear Parents

This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for **next** week.

In *Literacy*, students will be learning about Greek and Roman myths and legends. We will begin by focusing on Theseus and the Minotaur. We will have listened to the story, retold the story and written a recount as part of Big Writing.

In *Numeracy*, students will be revising their understanding of place value, before moving onto dividing and multiplying by 10 and 100. We will also be revisiting worded problems.

In *Science*, students will be starting their new topic 'forces'. We start by looking at push and pull forces before attempting to measure forces using Newton Meters.

In *IPC*, students will be exploring their new topic called 'Gateways to the World', which is focused on airports. Children have taken part in the entry point where they visited NAISAK airport in school and had to navigate the airport systems. They checked their bags in, passed through security and had to find their gate. Check Facebook for photos!

In *Art*, students will be using sketching skills to draw a realistic representation of their hand. They will be focusing on observation skills.

In *ICT*, students will continue their topic all around presenting sport reports. They will start by watching sporting highlights and trying to identify what information is shared with viewers by focusing on what is said, written and shown.

For *PSHE*, students will be thinking about resilience and what it means to keep going and not give up if things are hard.
