MEETING MINUTES

1. Welcome and Principal's Address

Rita Ransome, Co-chair, called the meeting to order at 8:04pm. Rita welcomed the attendees and introduced the DCA - a volunteer, social events organisation regulated by the Registry of Societies with a small elected committee and other committees made up of parent volunteers. All parents of DCIS students are automatically a member of the DCA so we welcome you to come help out.

Simon Mann, Principal, thanked the DCA, in particular Rita and Karyn, for the great year we've had. We are looking forward to another great year ahead and will work with the current government restrictions to continue our growth as a community. He thanked Zoe for linking the DCA to DCIS.

2. Overview of 2019-2020 Activities

Rita summarised the DCA events in 2019-2020. We accomplished a lot despite the school year being cut short by the pandemic and are proud of what we were able to achieve. Thank you to all the invaluable volunteers who came out to help! We couldn't have done it without you!

In Term 1, we had the used uniform sale, welcome picnic, Halloween event, Christmas Fayre and some Happy Hours. We are proud that we held the first ever Secondary Halloween event, which was very successful and well received by the students.

In Term 2, we were able to hold the used uniform sale, Secondary discos and a quiz night before the Circuit Breaker occurred. Unfortunately, the rest of the events for Term 2 had to be cancelled in light of Covid-19.

In Term 3, we put together a virtual Teacher's Appreciation. Thank you to all the parents who had their kids submit their thanks online to our teachers. They really appreciated the thanks.

The DCA also successfully led the class rep network, worked with the Student Council in its charity drives, and presented graduation gifts to the graduating classes in Y6, Y11 and Y13. Least but not all, the DCA, helped to decorate the school for various holidays, including Halloween, Christmas, and Chinese New Year.

Thank you again to all the parents who volunteered to help us make last year a successful year.

3. Financial report, including charity donation

Karyn Pereira, Treasurer, presented the financial accounts for 2019-2020. The DCA had an overall balance of around \$30k, and a net profit of \$4781. The majority of our income was derived from the

used uniform sales, Christmas Fayre and Halloween. Ticketed events like Halloween generally fund themselves. Money raised at events are used to reinvest in future events and charity donations. The healthy balance was also due to cancellation of the Teachers Appreciation Tea.

For charity, we donated a total of \$10k:

- \$6k Riding for the Disabled
- \$3k HOME
- \$1k Foodbank

For this year, we have also committed \$10k:

- \$6k Riding for the Disabled
- \$4k TBD approved migrant worker charity
