This letter has been sent home to inform you about your child's learning for next week.

In *Literacy*, we will be starting a new topic using 'Big Writing Adventures'. We will look at the structure and language used in an incident report before writing a narrative about an incident of our own.

In *Numeracy*, we will be ordering seven digit numbers, round whole and decimal numbers and then using negative numbers in context.

In *Science*, we are learning what deforestation is and the negative impact it has on the environment.

In IPC, the students are working in groups to organise and plan a television broadcast based on an oil spill.

In ICT, we will be taking part in the 'Lego Challenge'. The aim will be to design and build a sustainable city or building out of Lego.

In PSHE, we will be understanding the feelings we have when we experience loss in our lives. We will be talking about strategies we can use to cope with loss, as well as understanding how to be empathetic towards others.

For *Spellings*, students will receive their spelling lists on Thursday and will be tested on the list the following week. Students will have 11 words to learn during the course of the week.
