

## **Dear Parents,**

We would like to let you know about the third instalment of our Student Survey that is going to be launched in the coming weeks. The survey will be used to evaluate the impact of some of our Nord Anglia Education programmes. We strongly believe that our programmes benefit students in a number of ways, in particular by developing transferable skills that will help to prepare them for higher education, employment and society in general. We would like to continue collecting evidence to help investigate this impact, and also to ensure we continue to improve our programmes in the future.

The survey will include a 10 minute online questionnaire that students will take throughout May and June.

### **About transferable skills**

The survey will ask your children to respond to a set of questions that are focused around a range of skills. The skills that are particularly focused upon in the survey include: collaboration, confidence, creativity, critical thinking, global awareness, leadership, perseverance and problem solving.

### **How will the data be used?**

The data be used to determine the impact that our programmes have on our students across all 54 schools in the Nord Anglia Education family. Results will be gathered at school level, but will not be shared on a student basis so no child will be individually identifiable. Furthermore, the survey does not request or collect any identifiable personal information to ensure all student answers remain anonymous.
