## Monday 30 June at 08:45am

## Young Explorers 3-6 year olds

Assemble in the Early Year Foundations Stage (EYFS) Reception Area. If arriving by bus, the monitors will accompany the students to this area. If you are coming with your child, turn right when you go through the gate of the Primary campus. The reception area will be sign posted on the day.

We will be very busy on Monday getting to know students so we ask that you or their supervisors leave the children to get to know their class teacher and fellow students. Our teachers will work hard to make all students feel welcome so you **do not need to stay**. If your child is nervous we have staff who are used to dealing with this.
