**RE: INSTANT MESSAGING ON IPADS**

Dear Parents /Guardians,

With our students finishing school on Friday for three weeks, it is likely that children will want to stay in touch with their friends over the Christmas period, and may well use their iPads, and apps such as iMessage, to do so.

Class teachers have reminded children of how to use instant messaging appropriately, internet etiquette and what to do if they receive a message that they feel uncomfortable about.

We would like to take this opportunity to suggest that you periodically check their conversations, and remind your child to talk to you if they receive a message or contact that they feel is inappropriate. Contacts may also be blocked via the iPad's Settings, which your child will be able to show you.
