BIS Successes 2018



IB Diploma Results

- BIS Average Diploma score: 36.4 Points (IB world Average is 29.7 Points)
- BIS Diploma pass rate: 100% (IB World Average 80%)
- Highest Score achieved by a BIS Student : 45 Points (This is the highest possible score and achieved by less than 1% of students worldwide)
- BIS Diploma Scores of 40+: 24%

The above IB average score is the second best performance in BIS history.


- 68.4 % of grades achieved by our students were A*/A (UK Average 22%)

- 47 Students (39%) gained 8 or more A/A*






Driver's Code of Conduct

In order to keep our children safe on the roads outside BIS, both before and after school, please can you spend a few minutes of your time discussing the following points with your drivers.

- Never stop on or near to a pedestrian crossing in order to ensure that our families can cross the
 road safely, please instruct your driver to park as far away from the main gates as possible to avoid
 congestion. Try walking a short distance to keep cars down to a minimum.
- No cars should be parked for long periods of time outside of school ask your driver to meet you at
 a convenient location away from the school gates and please ask them to never double park as this
 stops the flow of traffic at peak times.
- Never U Turn along the stretch of road outside EY&I, JC and SC tell your driver to drive away from school and if they have to U Turn, please do so on the wider, less congested roads. Try the route past JC along Nguyen Van Huong, as an alternative way to get home – it may take a few extra minutes driving but it will save the time you spend in traffic.
- Ask your driver to show respect to our guards and follow their instructions they are there to keep
 you all safe and have a difficult job when drivers ignore their instructions.
- Explain to your driver that their actions reflect upon your family ask them to respect all of our school community to make our school the very best that it can be.


