



Younger students:

For our students who are non-francophone (without a minimum level in French of B2), the school organises French as a Foreign Language "FLE" lessons.

According to their age and level of French, these students will be set in special classes, or taken out of class during some periods.

This will allow the students to improve their French, while validating the academic year.



9th & 10th Grade French as a Foreign Language

For students who are non-francophone FLE support (max. 8 periods FLE per week to help integration to a French programme) or FLE class (12 period FLE)

Full immersion in French

*FLE = Français Langue Etrangère

All subjects in French (FLE, maths, sciences, history, geography, art, gym + English lessons

Exam: Delf (French) B2

Objective: validation of the school year (integration into a francophone class after 1-2 years)



11th & 13th Grade French as a Foreign Language (min. number of students: 5)

For students who are motivated to take 1 "gap" year in order to study French intensively, in small FLE classes, before returning back home to finish their studies, while validating the academic year.

Full immersion in French

*FLE = Français Langue Etrangère

All subjects in French (FLE* 13 periods + sciences, history/geography, art and gym)

- Maths in English
- English lessons (advanced level)
