

Filming your child for BISB KS1/Year 2.

Please make sure the film (15-20 minutes maximum) shows as many of the following things as possible:

- Your child playing in the company of other children- we appreciate that if your child does not have siblings, this may not be possible at this difficult time.
- Your child drawing, writing their name and writing/forming letters if they are already able to do this.
- Your child following instructions, ideally in English – if they have limited English the instruction can be in their first language. ☑
- Ask your child to explain something about their favourite toy or explain something they are interested in. This could be a television programme, a book or an event such as a visit to the zoo that they are recalling. This will be in English ideally or their home language if English is too limited.
- Your child counting and possibly solving simple addition and/or subtraction problems if they are already able to do this.
- Your child reading for a few minutes if they have started to read. Again, ideally in English, but where English is too limited, reading in other languages is also helpful.
- Your child walking and going up a flight of stairs if available.
- Your child rolling balls away from them and stopping balls rolling towards them.
