Types of VSL

To ensure a balance of screen time for students during Virtual School Learning we have identified three types of lesson.

LIVE	<p>This is a normal interactive lesson with students and teachers collaborating and working on curriculum content and skills development.</p> <p><i>This type of lesson will involve students interacting online for the majority of the lesson.</i></p>
AFL	<p>This type of lesson will focus on Assessment For Learning and will involve students completing tasks to consolidate and enhance their skills and understanding through a mixture of online and offline activities. Teachers will be available throughout the lesson to provide individual and group support to students. This lesson may also involve students collaborating in separate TEAM channels on activities.</p> <p><i>This provides students with the opportunity to mix working online with working away from the computer depending on the task throughout the lesson to balance screen time.</i></p>
NT	<p>This type of lesson will focus on activities based away from the computer using printed worksheets, textbooks, reading, creative development of ideas on paper, etc. Teachers will set an activity that while may require an initial access to the computer, will be biased primarily of screen.</p>

Guidelines which must be followed by teachers and students:

- Every lesson will begin online with the teacher taking a register and providing instructions verbally/written to students.
- All students are expected to join the lesson TEAM at the beginning of the lesson and at the end.
- Lessons will start at normal lesson times as per the timetable.
- The duration of all lessons will be 45minutes. Students have 15min breaks between lessons when teachers should not set work to be completed.
- Homework will be set as per the homework timetable included in this document.
- Students can, but are not required, to switch on their web cameras.
- If web cameras are used, students must ensure that they are appropriately dressed and that the background should be neutral.
