

Filming your child for BISB

Please make sure the film (10-15 minutes maximum) shows as many of the following things as possible:

- Your child playing in the company of other children.
- Your child mark making (could be with a crayon, pencil or painting).
- Your child following instructions – if they have limited English and are 6 or below the instruction can be in their first language.
- Ask your child to explain something about their favourite toy or explain something they are interested in. This could be a television programme, a book or a recent event such as a visit to the zoo that they are recalling. This can be in English or their home language.
- Your child counting objects (if they are at this point in their development).
- Your child walking and going up a flight of stairs.
- Your child rolling balls away from them and stopping balls rolling towards them.

Please **do not** film the following but confirm that your child can feed themselves and visit the toilet independently and are not currently using nappies (diapers).
