

## **PE Kit Policy 2021-2022**

Students are expected to bring their own kit to every Physical Education lesson. If a student is unfit to participate in a PE lesson they are still expected to bring and change into their PE kit. A medical note or note in their student planner signed by their parent/guardian will allow them to participate in an alternative, appropriate activity or role, for example: as a coach; scorer; umpire/referee or peer evaluator.

The agreed PE kit is listed below:

### **Indoor Activities**

- Clean non-marking indoor trainers
- Navy blue shorts/skirts
- Navy blue with house colour trim (Secondary) Grey (Primary) T-shirt with the school logo
- Pair of white socks in the Gymnastics block

### **Aquatic Activities**

- Appropriate swimwear (girls should wear a one-piece swimsuit; boys should wear swimming trunks/shorts)
- Swimming cap
- Towel
- Goggles and flip-flops are highly recommended
- Plain navy blue or black rash vests are optional

### **Outdoor Activities**

When students are taking part in outdoor activities, they are expected to wear the appropriate clothing in accordance with the sport, facility and weather.

Items listed for Indoor Activities are all acceptable. However, students will need a separate pair of trainers for outdoor use. For the sports fields, students may also wear astro boots. Football boots with screw-in or moulded studs/blades are not permitted.

Students are also permitted to wear the following additional items:

- Grey hoodie (Secondary) Navy blue sweater or fleece (Primary) with the school logo
- Navy blue tracksuit/jogging bottoms
- Plain navy blue/black leggings
- Plain navy blue or black technical base layers underneath PE kit
- Plain navy blue or black sports gloves and woollen hat
- Plain navy blue or black cap

For football, students are strongly advised to wear shin pads with plain navy blue or black long socks. For BISB Wolves football training, shin pads are compulsory for all squad members.

Teachers will provide guidance to all students regarding appropriate kit for PE activities where necessary.

### **Jewellery**

No jewellery (including earrings and friendship bracelets) are to be worn during lessons or Co-Curricular sports activities and BISB Wolves training sessions. Students may, at the discretion of the class teacher/PE teacher/coach, allow a newly installed stud to be covered by tape until the stud can be removed. All long hair must be tied back.

At BISB we are sensitive to the medical and cultural needs of all of our students and if jewellery is worn due to these reasons, students may still be asked to remove or cover them for health and safety reasons at the discretion of the PE staff.
