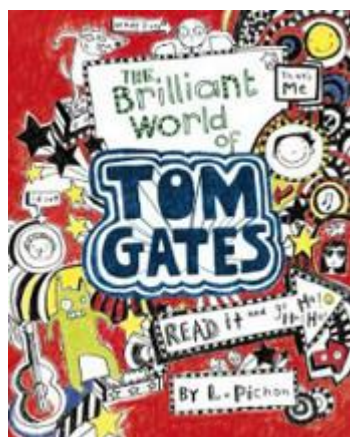


# Book Club choices on Global Classroom

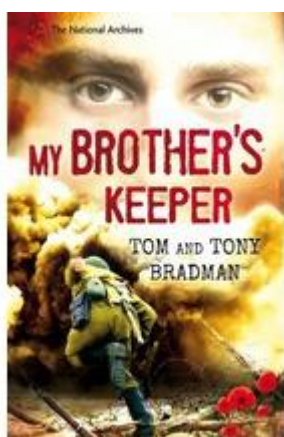
This year, we'll be reading and discussing books together, and also sharing our own recommendations and doing other activities. If you can, try to read each choice in advance before the discussion opens.

## Book Club choices 2014-15



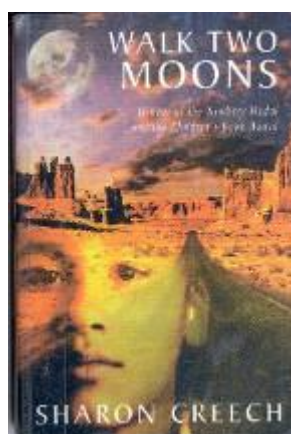
**September/October 2014:** *The Brilliant World of Tom Gates* by Liz Pichon

Tom Gates is a master of excuses, expert doodler, and comic story writer extraordinaire. This book takes the form of Tom's battered homework diary, crammed with his scribbles and stories.



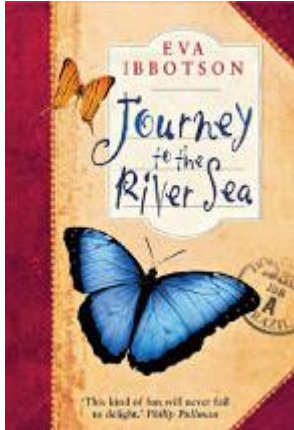
**November/December 2014:** *My Brother's Keeper* by Tony Bradman

Tony Bradman was our writing competition judge last year. As part of our commemoration of World War 1, we'll read his story of Alfie, who signs up to fight in the trenches aged just 14. But the reality of war is very different from his dreams of glory...



**January/February 2015:** *Walk Two Moons* by Sharon Creech

The story of thirteen-year-old Salamanca Tree Hiddle, who longs to be reunited with her missing mother. As they travel across the country to Idaho to find her, Sal tells her Gran and Gramps the "extensively strange story" of her friend Phoebe Winterbottom.



**April/May 2015:** *Journey to the River Sea* by Eva Ibbotson

Orphan Maia is sent from her English boarding school to the fabulous wilderness of the Amazon jungle to live with distant relatives. But Maia's relatives are not all they seem. Now she and a mysterious Indian boy, Finn, must flee for their lives up the great river. Can they survive in this world of anacondas and crocodiles, poisonous trees and strange, impossible animals?
