## History

Emalaikat has been present in the area of Turkana for 25 years. Its main aim is to implement projects to effectively relieve poverty and sickness. Emalaikat also preserves and protects good health by providing and assisting in the provision of medical care and treatment. This includes preventative healthcare and the promotion of health education, focussing on the cause of diseases. In Turkana, many people are in conditions of need, hardship, sickness or distress as a result of physical, economic or environmental conditions like drought, earthquakes, flooding or other natural disasters. Or because of their social or economic circumstances. What differentiates Emalaikat from others is the permanent living status of the organisers in the area.
