



**Rules for the Scholarship Competition  
“The British School, Warsaw IB Scholarship”  
organised by The British School Sp. z o.o.**

**I GENERAL PROVISIONS**

**Article 1  
Title of the Competition**

The Rules presented hereunder set out the terms and conditions for participating in the competition entitled „The British School, Warsaw IB Scholarship” hereinafter referred to as the “Competition”.

**Article 2  
Objective of the Competition**

The objective of the Competition is to enable one winner thereof, whose parents would not otherwise be able to afford the fees of The British School in Warsaw (a non-public high school), to study at that school and to complete the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (“IB”). English is the language of study in the school.

**Article 3  
Organiser of the Competition**

The British School Sp. z o.o. with its premises in Warsaw, Limanowskiego 15, 02-943 Warsaw, registered by Regional Court in Warsaw, XIII Economic Division of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000342123, NIP 527-261-56-46 and the share capital amounting to PLN 35,005,000 (hereinafter referred to as the “Competition Organiser” or “The British School”) is the Organiser of the competition and the sponsor of the prize.

**Article 4  
Geographical Area**

The competition is to be organised within the area of the Masovian Voivodeship.

**Article 5  
Duration of the Competition**

The competition is open from 16th April 2015 to 31st May 2015.

## **II APPLICANTS**

### **Article 6 Applicants**

1. To be eligible, the following requirements must be met as of 1st May 2015:
  - a) the applicant is enrolled at third-form level in a public or non-public junior high school or at first-form level in a public or non-public senior high school situated within the territory of the Masovian Voivodeship or equivalent level in a different education system, including class '0' (Pre-IB) in a school preparing students for the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma, situated within the territory of the Masovian Voivodeship;
  - b) the applicant has a reasonable level of fluency in both spoken and written English;
  - c) the average net (i.e. after taxation) monthly per capita income of the applicant's household does not exceed PLN 8,000 in the 2014 calendar year;
  - d) the applicant does not currently attend any school managed by The British School;
  - e) the applicant has not previously been expelled from The British School.
  
2. The income referred to under Art. 1 (c) encompasses all earnings, whether subject to or exempt from taxation and includes remuneration arising out of any employment relationship, payments from any other civil contract, profits accruing from any business activity, social security benefits, alimony, maintenance, child support, welfare, prizes, winnings etc.
  
3. No child of any employee of the Competition Organiser or of any person in a mandatory relationship with the Competition Organiser or of any person in any other relationship with the Competition Organiser governed by mandatory regulations or of any member of the Jury referred to in Art. 8 of these Rules or of any family member of any of the above mentioned persons, up to second degree relatives, shall be eligible to enter the Competition.

## **III RULES AND PROCEDURE OF THE COMPETITION**

### **Article 7 Competition Entry and Rules**

1. In order to enter the Competition, the Applicant needs to complete the questionnaire which requires, inter alia, the following data:
  - name of the Applicant,
  - residential address, telephone number, and e-mail address of the Applicant,
  - date of birth of the Applicant,
  - information about the school and class attended by the Applicant,
  - information about languages spoken by the Applicant,
  - information about the Applicant's school performance, including his/her final marks over the last two years and his/her conduct mark,
  - name(s) and residential address(es) of the Applicant's parent(s) / legal guardian(s),
  - completed essay explaining why they wish to study at The British School,
  - consent of the parent(s) / legal guardian(s) of the Applicant to enter and participate in the Competition and for the processing of personal data

and to register as an Applicant by submitting the questionnaire to the Organiser.  
Registration is open until May 31st 2015.

2. Those registered Applicants who meet the criteria set out herein may qualify to participate further in the Competition. Applicants who qualify for the Competition will be notified via e-mail of the date and the other details of the Competition.

3. Applicants who further qualify for the Competition will have to take an English Proficiency Test which for successful candidates will be followed up by an interview.

Before the interview, the Applicant is obligated to submit documents containing: the consent of the Applicant's parent(s) / legal guardian(s) to enter and participate in the Competition and for the processing of their personal data and those of the Applicant as well as a declaration from their parent(s) / legal guardian(s) that their household's average net (i.e. after taxation) monthly per capita income in the 2014 calendar year did not exceed PLN 8,000. Should the Organiser discover that the Applicant has not submitted any of the above specified documents, the Organiser shall request him/her to submit the missing document. An Applicant who fails to submit any of the above specified statements shall not be eligible to win the Competition.

4. The winner of the Competition will be the Applicant who meets the criteria set out herein and who is judged best by the Jury. The Organiser reserves the right for the Jury to make a judgement at their sole discretion.

5. The result of the Competition will be announced to the Applicants via e-mail or by registered mail or by courier at latest on 30<sup>th</sup> of June 2015. The Organiser may also announce the winner publicly. The Organiser reserves the right not to award the Prize described herein to any of the Applicants.

6. The winner of the Competition, in addition to being notified of his/her victory, shall receive two copies of a contract, signed by the Organiser, between his/her parent(s) / legal guardian(s) and the Organiser concerning his/her admission to high school. The Contract shall contain the same terms and conditions that apply to other students, in accordance with the prize awarded.

7. The Organiser reserves the right to request the parent(s) / legal guardian(s) of Applicants who qualified for Competition to provide copies of documents confirming the information contained in the declaration submitted to the Jury pursuant to the provisions of Art. 7.1 and 7.3.

## **IV JURY**

### **Article 8**

#### **Jury**

1. A Jury ("Jury") shall be appointed by the Organiser and shall comprise the Principal of the Schools managed by the Organiser and the Deputy Principal responsible for the IB programme. The Jury shall be responsible for overseeing the Competition, evaluating Applicants, awarding prizes and any possible complaints. The Organiser reserves the right to change the members of the Jury.

2. The Jury's decisions evaluating Applicants are final and binding. There is no right of appeal.

## **V PRIZE**

### **Article 9 Prize**

1. The Winner of the Competition shall receive a prize worth 187,515 (one hundred eighty seven thousand five hundred and fifteen PLN) in total, which shall comprise of:

- a) the admission fee, tuition fee and the lump-sum costs of the International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations (including the same textbooks provided to other students) for two years of studies at the non-public high school managed by the Organiser. This does not include the costs of preparing for the IB examinations or any other examination the Applicant may wish to take during his/her course of study. Nor does it include the costs of any excursions that may be required as part of the IB programme.

and

- b) the cash component in the amount of 1/9 of the described in point a) prize, designed to cover the withholding of personal income tax.

2. Neither the prize nor any part thereof will be redeemed in cash. The Winner of the Competition shall not be obliged to cover the refundable deposit stated in the Organiser's School Fee List.

3. The prize shall be handed over in two stages:

- a) The first part of the prize, to cover the funding of the admission fee and tuition fee for the first year of the IB diploma programme, shall be handed over together with its corresponding cash component designed to cover the withholding of personal income tax, on the date the Competition winner commences his/her education at the high school managed by the Organiser.

- b) The second part of the prize, to cover the funding of the tuition fee and the lump-sum costs of the International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations for the second year of the IB diploma programme, shall be handed over together with its corresponding cash component designed to cover the withholding of personal income tax, on the date the Competition winner commences his/her second year of education at the high school managed by the Organiser.

The satisfactory completion of the first year is required before handing over the second year of the IB diploma programme. In the event that the Competition winner fails to successfully complete the first year or fails to commence the second year of education at that high school, the second part of the prize shall not be handed over.

4. The Organiser declares that the lump-sum costs of the International Baccalaureate (IB) examinations shall cover exam fees up the total amount of PLN 3,000.

5. The Organiser declares that it shall not provide the Competition winner with accommodation, board, financial support, care or supervision outside the school hours at the high school it manages. The Organiser further declares that it shall not cover any other costs than those listed as prize components under Art. 9.1.

**Article 10**  
**Accepting or Declining the Prize**

1. The parent(s) / legal guardian(s) of the Competition winner shall inform the Organiser in writing (by a letter delivered to the premises of the Organiser or by registered mail) within 3 days of receiving the notification whether they accept or decline the prize. Together with their acceptance statement, the parent(s) / legal guardian(s) of the Competition winner shall return one signed copy of the Contract between them and the Organiser on the education of the student, referred to in Art. 7.6. In the event that they fail to return the signed copy of the Contract to the Organiser, the winner shall be deemed to have declined the prize. The candidate shall become a student of The British School in Warsaw when his/her parent(s) / legal guardian(s) accept the prize.

2. In the event that the winner declines the prize before the commencement of the first year of secondary education, he/she shall be deemed to have declined the whole prize. In such case, the prize may be awarded to the Applicant whose assessment was judged second best by the Jury.

3. If the winner declines the prize at any other time, the prize shall not be awarded to another Applicant. In the event that the parent(s) / legal guardian(s) of the winner decide to decline the prize on a date other than that stipulated in Art.10.1, they shall promptly notify the Organiser in writing of their decision.

**VI COMPLAINT PROCEDURE**

**Article 11**  
**Filing Complaints**

1. Complaints shall not concern substantial issues, which are definitively resolved by the Jury, in accordance with Art. 8.2 of the Competition Rules. A letter of complaint should contain the name, address and telephone number of the Applicant (in accordance with those given pursuant to Art. 7.1 of the Competition Rules) and a detailed description of the reason for complaint.

2. The Organiser shall analyse the complaint within 3 days from the receipt thereof and shall inform the complainant of its decision via e-mail and by registered mail.

**VII PERSONAL DATA**

**Article 12**  
**Personal Data**

Personal data about the Competition Applicants and their parent(s) / legal guardian(s) is administered by the Competition Organiser. By applying to enter the Competition, the parent(s) / legal guardian(s) of the Applicant express their consent for the processing of the above mentioned data by the Organiser and for the use thereof for the purposes of the Competition, including the public announcement of the names of the Competition winner. The personal data of the Applicants shall be processed for the purposes of the Competition and shall be made available only to the Jury. The personal data of the Competition Applicants and their parent(s) / legal guardian(s) shall not be used for marketing purposes but they may be processed for the legitimate purposes of the data administrator. Providing personal information is voluntary, however, failure to provide personal information shall prevent entry

to the Competition. The parent(s) / legal guardian(s) of each Applicant have access rights to their own personal data and to that of the Applicant. They also have the right to modify the data.

## **VIII FINAL PROVISIONS**

### **Article 13**

#### **Competition Announcements, Competition Rules**

1. The Competition was announced to the public by way of press advertisements and the Organiser's website.

### **Article 14**

#### **Participation Costs**

The Organiser shall not cover the costs associated with the Applicant's participation in any stage of the Competition, in particular travel, accommodation in Warsaw etc.

### **Article 15**

#### **Disqualification**

In the event of a breach of these Rules, the Jury may exclude the Applicant at any stage of the Competition.

### **Article 16**

#### **Other Issues**

The Polish Civil Code shall govern any matters not covered by these Rules.
