Taking part is simple.

1. Download the Group Stage Results Predictor spreadsheet from the Global Classroom and save it to your computer.
2. Use the drop down list to chose whether each match will see a 'home win', an 'away win' or a 'draw'. Make sure you fill in a prediction for every game in all eight groups.
3. Fill in your name, school and year group.
4. Save the completed form.
5. Go to the World Cup Talk forum in the Global Classroom.
6. Open the 'Competition: Group Stage Results Predictor' discussion.
7. Reply to the discussion, being sure to upload your completed prediction form.

The deadline

All entries must be received by the end of **Wednesday 11th June**, before the Group Stage competition starts.

Scoring

For each prediction you get correct you will receive **one** point. There are a total of 48 points available (6 matches in 8 groups).

The winning students will be those with the highest scores. The names of the winning students will be announced on the Global Classroom on **Friday 27th June**, at the end of the Group Stage. The winning students will receive a football related prize for the school.
