MIT-Nord Anglia STEAM Festival

Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics

We are delighted to announce that as part of Nord Anglia's partnership with the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT), 104 students from 26 schools across the world have the opportunity to travel to MIT in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA, to participate in the MIT – Nord Anglia STEAM Festival. The Festival is a week-long programme which provides unique learning opportunities specifically for our students at one of the world's leading educational institutions.

## Dates

Students will arrive in Cambridge, Massachusetts, USA, on Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2017 and depart on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2017 after a full week of workshops and activities hosted by MIT.

## Activities

Students will have the opportunity to collaborate with their peers from all over the world and participate in exciting workshops and activities delivered by leading MIT academics, as well as visiting the campuses of two of the best universities in the world (MIT and Harvard University). The activities have been co-created by NAE and MIT to increase students' understanding of STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art and mathematics), while developing their interdisciplinary learning and practical problem-solving skills.

Details of the specific activities planned for the week are provided in the annex to this letter, as well as within a promotional flyer for the trip which will be available shortly. There have been some inquiries about parents planning a coinciding visit but there is not an opportunity during the week's activities for this to happen.

#### Cost

The total cost of the trip, including flights, is 950 000 HUF. This payment will need to be made in full by 17th February 2017.

All meals, accommodation and transport costs incurred during the trip are included within this price. The hotel hosting the Nord Anglia trip is the Hyatt Regency Cambridge, which is situated next to the iconic River Charles.

Students will share a room with one other student from BISB of the same gender. The hotel is a short walk from MIT as students will walk between venues over the course of the trip, rather than being transported by vehicles.

Fully comprehensive travel insurance is also covered within the cost – more details of this will be available once students have been accepted onto the trip. You will not need to purchase additional travel insurance.

## **Application Process**

Due to the anticipated huge popularity of the trip and limited total number of students able to participate, each school can only send a maximum of 4 students age 10-12. Students in Year 8 who turn 13 this academic year are also eligible to apply.

To apply for a place, students should write a letter of up to 500 words explaining why they would like to attend the STEAM Festival at MIT this year. This letter should be endorsed with a parent's signature to indicate their support of the application. A paper copy of the letter should be handed to the school's Reception or directly to Mr Payn by 4pm on Monday 23rd January 2017.
