Nord Anglia Education and Juilliard to Develop Innovative Arts Curriculum for Nord Anglia's K-12 Schools

Program to launch in September 2015 at 10 Inaugural Schools in North America, Europe, China, and Southeast Asia

Nord Anglia students, faculty, and parents will also enjoy school-based engagement with Juilliard artists in the geographical vicinity or on tour. Future programs will be available not only to students enrolled at Nord Anglia's schools, but also to young people from the communities in which the schools are located.
