Hungary’s 1% tax laws allows you to donate 1% of your previous year’s paid personal income taxes to an approved charity and an additional 1% to a church. Donating enables you to support a worthy cause in Hungary and one which is of value to you and at no financial cost.

Karitatív Food for Life	Collects food for homeless and disadvantaged people

Budapest Bike Maffia	Collects donations for ones in need and delivers them by bicycle

Vasas Centenarium Alapitvany	Helps disadvantaged children by paying for their sporting activities in one of Budapest’s largest sports club
