

BOARDING ARRIVALS

We would be grateful if all parents could read the following advice, to confirm that they understand the measures put in place for the safety of our children, and then complete the declaration, returning it to us (boarding@cdl.ch) one day before the return of your child..

Arrival protocol and Hygiene precautions

Please announce the anticipated arrival details of your child as usual, to boarding@cdl.ch.

If arriving locally by private transport from the family home:

- Staff will greet you at the Boarding House.

For those taking flights:

- CDL will arrange collection at the airport, which is mandatory. Students will not be allowed to use public transport.
- Please ensure your child has masks and disinfectants for the travel.
- CDL staff will take a temperature of each child at the airport and ensure disinfectant and a mask is worn.
- At school, the Medical Centre will administer a Covid-19 test, and the child will then go to a single room in the House to await the results of this test. In this time, your child will stay in the room assigned, taken care of by staff here. Meals will be taken in the House. If term has started, they will follow the Virtual School Experience.
- When a negative test is confirmed, students will re-join their House and be able to go to lessons.
- If the test returns a positive result, your child will need to be isolated for 10 days, supervised by staff. Students will have single rooms, allocated bathroom facilities, and meals will be taken in the House. In this time, they will follow the Virtual School Experience. After the doctor has given the all clear, students will re-join their House and be able to go to lessons.

Please note:

- We will be checking that no student has a fever 3 times a day.
- We will provide hand sanitisers in all Houses and Common areas- students may bring their own private supply for their rooms.
- We require that students over the age of 15 wear masks in public areas when they cannot socially distance. We will provide some masks, but parents may want to ensure that students have their own mask, either washable, or disposable. We recommend a supply of 30 masks per week.
- Students will be allocated a single room until their test result arrives. They will then return to shared rooms.
- We will expect social distancing as much as possible.
- We will not allow students to use Public Transport.
- We will not allow students to go to Geneva without specific parental and staff authorisation.
- We will allow students off campus into Versoix, only with specific permission of parents and House Parents, wearing masks.
