The Campus

The curriculum on offer

At BCB we teach the English National Curriculum, adapted to an international environment. Throughout our core curricula and programmes, we help your child to develop a global mindset and nurture essential skills such as creativity, collaboration and resilience. We want every student to become lifelong learners, to try something new, and above all, to be ambitious.

In Years 10 and 11, students at BCB will work towards obtaining (I) GCSE qualifications offered by the Cambridge and Edexcel examination boards. The two-year (I)GCSE



programme is academically rigorous, and recognised to be amongst the best in the world for this age range of students. Many of the subjects will have specific international elements and content, developed by specialists to make the subject matter relevant to students worldwide.

The British College of Brazil is a candidate school* for the IB Diploma Programme. IB World Schools share a common philosophy - a commitment to high-quality, challenging, international education that we believe is important for our students.

Along with the English National Curriculum, our students learn

Portuguese and Brazilian history, culture and geography. The British College of Brazil offers double certification. By obtaining the Brazilian diploma, students are allowed to continue their studies in Brazil, as the school is fully certified by the Ministry of Education.

Our educational approach enables every student to reach high levels of academic and social success. Our students are confident, entrepreneurial learners and year on year, their standardised exam results exceed global averages.



