NBPS VIRTUAL LEARNING EXPERIENCE DURING COVID-19 TRIMESTER 3 (SPRING 2020-2021)

In response to the challenges posed by the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic in Spring 2020, North Broward Preparatory School adapted a Virtual School Experience (VSE). The combination of synchronous learning sessions fused with asynchronous, independent practice/study ensured the continued provision of a mission driven, high quality, rigorous academic experience for all students. Through the NBPS VSE, NBPS grading, report cards and transcripts remained the same.

For the 2020-2021 academic year, high school students shifted to a hybrid model with the option to attend in person full- or part-time or remain virtual. All students attended school for the equivalent number of hours as every other year to maintain the integrity of the curriculum.

Regarding end-of-year examinations and assessments, our school proceeded with implementing the necessary requirements for successful completion of AP and IB programs. All students enrolled in AP courses completed their exams. All IB students submitted required materials for completion of their courses despite cancellation of formal IB exams. Cumulative final exams were suspended in 2020 and 2021 in order to extend the teaching of essential skills until the end of year.

ARTS ACADEMY

Arts Academy students train with professionals from our diverse faculty and staff to guest artists from top arts organizations. We offer pathways in visual art, dance, music, media arts, theatre, and interdisciplinary arts. In addition to their academic schedule, students hone their skills and develop their unique artistic voice through their core arts classes (12 credits) and afterschool performances, productions, and competitions.

N.E.S.T. (Nurturing, empathic, support team) provides an "anchor" of social and emotional support for every single student by fostering deep, meaningful, and authentic relationships with a N.E.S.T counselor and fellow students. Our curriculum provides students with the opportunity to develop SEL skills and a sense of belonging and purpose within the school.

LIGHTHOUSE POINT ACADEMY (LPA) PROGRAM

The Lighthouse Point Academy (LPA) program has been designed to present the NBPS curriculum to students of average to gifted intelligence who have been diagnosed with mild-to-moderate specific learning disabilities and who require specialized learning accommodations. LPA students work within smaller teacher-to-student ratios that more effectively accommodate and guide students with varied learning styles. LPA emphasizes the process involved in more personalized learning, as well as curricular content and actively encourages students to develop their own executive skills, self-awareness, and learning strategies. The goal of LPA is to encourage students to accentuate their strengths and address their learning needs as they grow to be caring, responsible, and capable adults and college students.
