Classes & Descriptions

Art After School

Using a variety of different mediums and techniques, both 2D and 3D, students will explore concepts inspired by great artists and their works, delving into color, line, texture, and other elements of art. Through paintings, collage, clay sculpture, and other multimedia projects, students will draw parallels across space and time and experience personalized problem solving and creative self-expression.

Chess

The classic game of chess stimulates a child's problem-solving aptitude, focus, and critical thinking abilities, along with providing lifelong lessons in patience, foresight, and evaluation. Chess is also proven to help children build mathematic and science skills and self-discipline. The Village School has one of the top scholastic chess programs in the country, available to children of all skill levels beginning in Kindergarten. Our chess team is taught by master-level coaches, and has a long history of state and national championships for both the team as a whole and individual member.

*Cook, Learn, Grow-Kids Can Cook!

Kids Can Cook- (Tuesdays): Does your child LOVE to cook? Do you have a picky eater? Our food literacy program teaches age appropriate techniques, food origins, seasonal recipes, and kitchen safety while having hands-on fun! Students gain self-confidence while reinforcing core academics. Sample themes: Eat The Rainbow—colorful fruits and veggies, 'Tis The Season—seasonal food literacy, Melting Pot—classic American flavors, Grow It, Cook It—food origins, Food Groups—an introduction, and Holidays—celebrate through food. **There will be an additional \$50 supply fee added to this class.*

Junior Chef (Mondays): The kitchen is the hub of nourishment, learning, and growing individually and as a community. Our Junior Chefs program offers students an experience in culinary arts through age-appropriate techniques, creativity enriched with literacy and STEM-based activities and a community food project. Sample themes: Science and Math in the Kitchen, STEM Enrichment, Food as Fuel—food groups expanded, and Community Food Project—helping others. **There will be an additional \$50 supply fee added to this class.*

*Dance

This program is designed to teach kids the basic fundamentals of dance in a variety of dance techniques and styles. In the Fall semester, we will cover ballet and hip-hop. The students can start to develop as performers, feel comfortable letting go, and expressing themselves through the popular art form of dance; all while learning things about themselves and different styles. This class will be so much fun for everyone involved! The attire will be black leotard and pink tights with ballet shoes. Students are not required to dress out for class, but will need these things for the fall recital. **There will be an additional \$40 Costume fee added to this class.*

Giraffes Can Dance

Enjoy wonderful stories, foster a love for reading, and learn reading comprehension skills in a fun and engaging way! After story time, children will use the six art modalities: visual art, music, creative movement, poetry, and storytelling to illustrate the various important areas of reading comprehension. Each week, we'll focus on one of the following: main idea, making connections, visualizing, inference, author's message, and re-telling.

Global Academic Coaching: The Great Orator's Club

This exciting public speaking club gives members an opportunity to develop the leader within by becoming confident communicators. Students will learn how to capture an audience by delivering dynamic and lively speeches, using intonation, and correct grammar and poise. At each meeting, roles such as President, MC, and timer are some positions students will be given, further promoting their organizational and critical thinking capabilities. Every week, students will vote for the 'Best Speaker' and 'Best Evaluator' and winners will be awarded a badge. At the end of the program, all members will receive a certificate of completion.

Tennis

Tour-A-Culture

Learning about our diverse world has never been more FUN! We put the A for Arts and Language Immersion in S.T.E.A.M. by offering age-appropriate, question-based and hands-on learning for kids.
