

ISRMUN Rules and Regulations

- Remember to state your point before speaking.
- Always respect the opinions and comments of others.
- Avoid the use of personal pronouns. Judges in the ICJ and Generals in the JWC are permitted to use personal pronouns during the event.
- Be on time for all of the sessions. Participants are encouraged to join Zoom at least 5 minutes before the start of each session.
- Eating, drinking, or chewing gum is not permitted during the committee sessions.
- Participants must treat other participants, members of the Chair, staff, advisors and the Secretariat respectfully.
- English must be spoken at all times during committee sessions.
- Participants must have their cameras turned on and microphones muted at all times unless they have been recognized to speak by the Chair.
- The links and login information for the sessions are not to be shared with nonparticipants.
- Participants will be permitted to use additional electronic devices during the session, however, disruptive use of these devices is not permitted.
- Group and private messages in the chat must be used correctly and in a respectful manner. Any use of profanity or inappropriate language will result in a warning.
- Participants that exhibit rude, aggressive or disruptive behaviour during the session will receive a warning. If the behaviour continues, they will be removed and locked out of the session.
- If a participant must leave the session, they should send a private message to the Director in order to notify the Chair of their departure.
