The NBPS community is remarkably diverse with day & residential students from over 27 countries. NBPS's strong college preparatory academic programs are complemented by enrichment offerings in theater arts, music, visual and graphic arts, computer science, STEAM and other subjects. NBPS provides students with a global perspective as a function of its membership in Nord Anglia Education and an International Baccalaureate World School.

NBPS VIRTUAL/HYBRID LEARNING EXPERIENCE

In Spring 2020, North Broward Preparatory School adapted a Virtual School Experience (VSE). The combination of synchronous learning sessions fused with asynchronous, independent practice/study ensured the continued provision of a mission driven, high quality, rigorous academic experience for all students. For the 2020-2021 academic year, the high school shifted to a hybrid model with the option to attend in person full- or part-time or remain virtual. All students attended school for the equivalent number of hours to maintain the integrity of the curriculum and grading, report cards and transcripts remained the same. All students enrolled in AP courses completed their exams. All IB students submitted required materials for completion of their courses despite cancellation of formal IB exams. Cumulative final exams were suspended in 2020 and 2021 in order to extend the teaching of essential skills until the end of year.

N.E.S.T (Nurturing, Empathic, Support Team)

Provides an “anchor” of social and emotional support for every single student by fostering deep, meaningful, and authentic relationships with a N.E.S.T counselor and fellow students. Our curriculum provides students with the opportunity to develop SEL skills and a sense of belonging and purpose within the school.

ARTS ACADEMY

Arts Academy students train with professionals from our diverse faculty and staff to guest artists from top arts organizations. We offer pathways in visual art, dance, music, media arts, theatre, and interdisciplinary arts. In addition to their academic schedule, students hone their skills and develop their unique artistic voice through their core arts classes (12 credits) and afterschool performances, productions, and competitions.

LIGHTHOUSE POINT ACADEMY (LPA) PROGRAM

The Lighthouse Point Academy (LPA) Program has been carefully designed to present the rigorous NBPS curriculum to students of average to gifted intelligence who have been diagnosed with mild-to-moderate learning differences. LPA provides students with teachers who are subject area experts that are also uniquely prepared to provide differentiated instruction in supportive learning environments. LPA students enroll in core curricular classes that incorporate smaller teacher-to-student ratios that more effectively accommodate and guide students with varied learning styles. LPA emphasizes the metacognitive processes that create more personalized learning, as well as curricular content. Simultaneously, LPA shepherds students as they develop their own executive skills, self-awareness, and learning strategies. The goal of LPA is to encourage students to accentuate their strengths and address their learning needs as they grow to be caring, responsible, and capable adults and college students.

ENTREPRENEURIAL STUDIES / LEARN TO START PROGRAM

The Learn to Start program drives learners to answer the three fundamental questions that every individual needs to be capable and competent in answering: Who are you? What can you do? How do you prove it? The curriculum guides learners to continue to investigate their answers to these questions by taking advantage of opportunities to take action, take risks, experience failure, and learn from those experiences. Answering these questions enables learners to achieve the three program outcomes of Empowerment, Wellness, and Performance. These outcomes are communicated through the learner's market-ready portfolio which makes transparent the learner's development as someone who acts independently and is aligned with the markets.
