Did you know...

- Primary, Middle, and Upper School currently run on different schedules, making it difficult for shared staff (like PE and MFL teachers) to coordinate lessons effectively.
- Some Primary students have had to miss their scheduled breaks because they were in lessons aligned with the Middle/Upper timetable, impacting their wellbeing and rest.
- The school currently has five different finish times, which can be challenging for families with children in multiple divisions and complicates transport and supervision.
- Primary students used to have lunch less than two hours after their morning snack, leading to food waste and reduced appetite.
- Middle and Upper School students often missed out on enrichment opportunities due to extended academic hours needed to meet curriculum demands.
- Shared outdoor spaces were sometimes used by different age groups at the same time, creating safety concerns and limiting the quality of both lessons and free time.
- IB students previously had an average of five free periods per week, which sometimes led to under-supervised, unproductive time while also having some periods run into their lunch or beyond the 15:30 finish time.
